ELIGIBILITY:

- a. No school will be eligible for Performance Incentive which does not fulfill following criteria of minimum number of students that must have appeared in PEC/BISE Exam from that school in the particular year for which the calculations are made.
- i) Primary School Level = 20
- ii) Elementary School Level =30
- iii) Secondary School Level = 40
- iv) Higher Secondary School Level = 30

- b. For High and Higher Secondary Schools the BISE Annual Exam of 2010 for Matric or for FA / F Sc will be considered and only those teachers will be eligible who remained posted for at least 9 months of the Academic Year 2009-10 in the eligible High and Higher Secondary Schools.
- c. For Primary schools and Elementary Schools the PEC Mean Score for the MCQs portion in the PEC Examination 2011 will be considered and only those teachers who remained posted for at least 9 months during the Academic Year 2010-11 in the eligible schools/ portion will be entitled to receive the incentive amount.
- d. Result of a school for 10th and 12th classes will be calculated on overall strength of the class and not on different groups i.e. Science Group, Arts Groups and Commerce Group etc.

DURATION AND MODE OF PAYMENT:

- a. Duration of the allowance will be from 1st July to 30th June of current FY (2010-2011) and the Incentive amount will be transferred in lump sum to the bank account of the eligible teacher of the selected school, as one transaction in the whole financial year and will not be provided on monthly basis.
- A teacher, even if transferred from a selected school, to a non selected School, will get performance based allowance.
