INSTRUCTIONS UNDER SECTION 12C OF THE PUNJAB PRIVATE EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS (PROMOTION & REGULATION) (AMENDMENT) ACT,2016, REGARDING ANTI NARCOTICS MEASURES FOR THE PUBLIC PRIVATE AND RELIGIOUS EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN PUNJAB

Kindly refer to Writ Petition No.237588/2018 and interim directions issued from court from time to time in the subject writ petition, the Competent Authority has directed all Private Institutions to follow the instructions as given below regarding eradication of drug abuse/narcotics from the educational institutions forthwith:

- 1. It is the responsibility of school administration that no student is involved in use & keeping of narcotics and contraband drugs.
- 2. Smoking is strictly prohibited inside and outside school premises.
- 3. School canteen to be regularly monitored and checked so that no banned item is available there.
- Custodians/ Security Gaurds of school to be specifically monitored and school administration to ensure that they are not involved in drug peddling.
- Medical screening (General Health Profile) of the students be initiated forthwith on the attached proforma. In case of suspicion of drugs use by a student, he/she may be referred to school councils for engaging parents and subsequent testing must be ensured.
- Schools will share result of sample tests with School Education Department on weekly basis through AEOs.
- 7. A rehabilitation mechanism to be developed for confirmed cases and confidentiality of such students to be ensured.
- 8. School administration to keep an eye on vendors outside schools and may report to concerned agencies if any suspicious activity is observed.

- 9. School councils to be activated more and to meet on regular basis on subject matter and awareness seminar may be arranged.
- 10. Steamers and banners should be placed at conspicuous places in school premises on drug abuse for creating awareness among students.
- 11. SED is going to start regular inspections of school premises and in case of any violation or any involvement of any student in drug abuse, the principal will be held responsible for drug abuse and 4.042/02/2023. action would be taken accordingly.
